

Rick fought to make sure Pennsylvania Seniors have a prescription drug plan under Medicare that not only dramatically lowers costs, but also prevents any Senior from ever being financially devastated due to the cost of their prescription drugs.

H.R. 1 (108th) Vote #459, 108th Congress 1st Session

Rick helped pass a tax cut for all Americans.
He also successfully fought to eliminate the marriage penalty tax, and to increase the per child tax credit.

H.R. 1836 (107th) Vote # 170, 107th; 1st Session; S. 6 (109th)

- Rick is the first Pennsylvania Senator in history to make the commitment to visit every one of our 67 counties every year. A commitment he's lived up to for over a decade.
- Rick introduced the "Neighborhood Children's Internet Protection Act." Passed by Congress as part of the "Internet Protection Act," this important legislation protects our children from internet predators. S. 1545 (106th)



- Rick is the author of the "CARE Act," which strengthens non-profit organizations that work on issues such as homelessness and drug addiction.

- Rick is the author of the "Pet Animal Welfare Statute (PAWS)," cracks down on puppy mills, who harm animals at the expense of unknowing pet owners. Rick has been praised by the National Humane Society for his work on this issue.

  S. 1139 (109th)
- Rick's wife Karen has had a number of successful careers, including being a nurse, a lawyer, and a published author.





- Rick was the architect of landmark legislation that created the "Farmland Preservation Program," which has since become one of the most successful conservation programs in history. S. AMDT. 3455 to S. 1541 (104th)
- Rick introduced the "Gasoline Affordability and Security Act" of 2005 which regulates price gouging and unfair pricing by the big oil companies. S. 1868 (109th)
- Rick wrote legislation that would increase the national minimum wage. SA 128 to S. 256 (109th)
- Rick has been a leader in the Senate successfully protecting critical funding for the "Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)," which sent millions of dollars to Pennsylvania to help low-income families pay for their heating bills. s. 2273, s. 2320 (109th)

Rick is a co-sponsor of Association Health Plan legislation, which helps Pennsylvania's Small businesses provide healthcare insurance for their employees. S. 406 (109th)

Rick has fought for increased enforcement of our nation's immigration laws, more funding for better tracking of illegal immigrants, and is a strong supporter of dramatically increasing funding for border security.

Vote #105, 109th Congress, 1st Session

Rick has been a leader in the fight to reform medical malpractice liability laws to cut down on the number of frivolous lawsuits that are driving Pennsylvania's doctors to move to other states.

Rick was instrumental in adding \$1.5 billion in emergency funding for the Department of Veterans Affairs, helping to ensure our servicemen and women receive the quality healthcare they deserve when they return home. SA 1071 (109th)

Rick was a co-sponsor of "Lock-Box" legislation which prevents the Washington politicians from taking money from the Social Security trust fund and spending it on any other program.

When the Hahnemann Medical School was being forced to close their doors, within one week Rick Santorum wrote and passed legislation providing critical funds, and saved this important Philadelphia healthcare facility.

Rick has a long history in eliminating Congressional abuses of taxpayer's money. He fought to close the scandal ridden House Bank, and put an end to Senators using taxpayer funds to subsidize their lunches and to receive haircuts at the Senate barber shop.

S. 668 (106th)

Rick is the author of the "Schools SAFE Act" which will help make sure Pennsylvania children will always be safe in school, and able to learn in a nurturing environment.

Rick joined with Democratic Senator Chris Dodd to introduce legislation to battle Lyme disease. This legislation will provide critical funding to help the over 30,000 Pennsylvanians diagnosed with this disease.

Rick successfully fought to protect billions of dollars in transportation funds for Pennsylvania, blocking a bill in the U.S. Senate that would have sent our taxes to other states. As a result, Pennsylvania will be able to increase spending for highways, bridges and transit projects by 20%.
